Series of 1994

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PEDDLING, HAWKING AND EXPOSING FOR SALE ANY ARTICLES OF COMMERCE IN PUBLIC PASSAGEWAY, AISLE AND SIDEWALK SURROUNDING THE PUBLIC MARKET, AND INSIDE MUNICIPAL HALL, JUSTICE HALL AND PUBLIC SCHOOL.

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Narvacan in session assembled.

Section 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as "The Municipal Anti-Peddling Ordinance."

Section 2. Definition of Terms. A) Peddler - is any person who, either for himself/herself or for another person on commission basis, travels from place to place to sell or offer for sell any commercial item with the exemption of periodicals such as newspapers, magazines and similar items.

B) Hawker - is any person who, either for self/herself or for another person on commission basis, cry out for sale commercial items except reading and sidewalk surrounding the public market.

Section 3. Prohibition - Peddler and hawker shall be prohibited to sale or offer for sale any commercial items except reading materials such as newspapers and magazines inside the Municipal Hall, Justice Hall and Public Schools, and in the passageway, aisle and sidewalk surrounding the public market.

Section 4. Exemption - Peddlers and hawkers who want for an exemption must secure permit from the Office of the Mayor and pay the corresponding fees, including thirty pesos ₱30.00 for each day they intend to do their business in the municipality.

Section 5. Penalty- Any person found violating any provision of the Ordinance shall upon conviction be sentenced to pay a fine of ₱100.00 for the first offense, ₱200.00 for the Second Offense and ₱300.00 and/or imprisonment of not less than one month no more than six month or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court for the third offense.

Section 6. Final Provision

A) Repealing Clause. All Municipal Ordinance, Municipal Executive Orders, Administrative Regulations, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with any of the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

B) Separability Clause. If, for any reason or reason, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof w/c are not affected thereby shall continue to be in force and effect.

C) Effectively Clause. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
