AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING VEHICLES WITHOUT ANY LIGHTS OR WITH DEFECTIVE LIGHTS TO TRAVEL DURING NIGHTTIME ALONG ANY NATIONAL, MUNICIPAL OR BARANGAY ROAD WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NARVACAN, ILOCOS SUR.

ARTICLE I

Section 1 - That there were many instances of vehicular accidents during nighttime involving vehicles without lights or with defective lights travelling along the roads and streets of the municipality of Narvacan, Ilocos Sur.

Section 2 - That vehicular accidents cause untoward incidents which cause deaths, injuries and destruction to properties of the people in the community.

Section 3 - Therefore, it is hereby prohibited for any person or persons to drive any vehicle such as trucks, ten wheelers, automobiles, passenger jeepneys, jeeps, tractors, bulldozers, "kuligligs", tricycles, motorcycles and other vehicles drawn by animals such as calesas and carts without the necessary lights or with defective lights to travel at nighttime along any road, whether National, Provincial, Municipal or Barangay Road, within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality of Narvacan, Ilocos Sur.

Section 4 - That any motor vehicle which has any non-working headlight, has no tail or brake lights are considered vehicles with defective lights are prohibited to travel at nighttime within the municipality of Narvacan, Ilocos Sur.

Section 5 - That those vehicles commonly known as "kuliglig", and other similar vehicles utilized for travel, as well as animal drawn vehicles without any illuminating device visible from both its front and rear sides are also included in the above prohibition.

Section 6 - Now therefore, any person or persons operating or driving any of those mentioned vehicles without lights or with defective lights in violation of this Ordinance, shall be imposed a penalty consisting of a fine in the amount of Three Hundred Pesos (P300.00) or imprisonment for not more than one (1) month, or both, at the discretion of the court.

ARTICLE II


Penal Provision:


